POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

There are no further requirements for this RPL; it is automatic and guaranteed and provides a saving on fees.

Graduates can also apply for Accreditation of Prior Certified Learning for module 3 of the Postgraduate Diploma in Dermatology studied through the Rila Institute of Health Sciences and awarded by the University of Plymouth (UK), with a time saving of 40 per cent. Graduates can then apply for credit from the Postgraduate Diploma to the Master of Science in the specialism awarded by the University of Plymouth.

Clinical attachments are also available in Australia and at university teaching hospitals overseas, providing the opportunity to observe skin cancer treatments and ask questions of experts.
